- At the time of registration, we ask that you provide the weeks that you plan to have your child
 attend the Club. We understand that plans may change as the summer progresses. Please let us
 know by the Monday of the week prior to a scheduled week if you no longer plan to use that
 spot. If you are on automatic payment, your card will be charged if you have not informed us of
 your planned non-attendance.
- Payments must be received by the WEDNESDAY prior to the week of attendance to ensure your spot. Families on automatic payment will have their cards charged on Tuesday. Space in Day Camp is limited and registration is accepted on a first come, first served basis.
- <u>Preference is given to families who need the service on a consistent basis.</u> If you fail to bring your child consistently, your spot may be given to someone on the waitlist.
- Space in the upcoming week will not be guaranteed without payment. Please see the registration form for exact dates.
- Payments can be made by exact cash amount, check or credit/debit card. Checks resulting in in insufficient funds will be charged a return fee and eliminated as a method of payment.
- Refunds may be granted if the request is made the WEDNESDAY prior to that week of Day Camp. There are no partial refunds for weeks not fully attended. This includes removal from the program due to disciplinary reasons and/or sickness.
- In the event of outstanding, incomplete or non-payment, your family will be unable to attend Club activities until payment has been made in full, no exceptions.
- If paying with cash, please come with the exact total as our Clubs do not carry change.
- Payments are accepted from 9:00 a.m. 5:30 p.m. Only authorized personnel (Membership Clerk or Branch Manager) can accept payments.

Special Needs

The Club is committed to providing the best possible experience for all participants. If your child has any special needs, please communicate those needs with staff at the time of registration. Our ratios are 1 adult for 20 youth in Day Camp and 1 adult for 15 youth for fieldtrips. We cannot provide one-on-one support. Children must be able to participate within their groups.

If your child requires medication while they are at the Club, please make sure to complete the medication form. Staff cannot administer medication without a completed form on file.

Adventure Camp Expectations

Camp hours are **7:30** a.m. to **5:30** p.m. Most Adventure Camp trips leave at 9:00 am (some may be earlier, please check the schedule to ensure you are on time.) Members need to be checked in and ready to go as the bus will be loaded and leaving on time each day. If a member misses the bus, they will be able to remain at the club but will be assigned to help a younger group for the day. Members who repeatedly miss the bus will be subject to removal from the program. Below you will find important policies and day-to-day procedures that will most likely apply to you. 	Please instruct your child that he/she should not leave the building unless accompanied by an adult staff member. This rule will also be stressed and reinforced by Boys & Girls Club staff.
	Please be prepared to always show your I.D. Anyone picking up a Club Member must provide
_	identification to the front desk at the time of pick up. No person will be allowed to remove children from

	the Club if they are not listed as an authorized person on the membership application, even if the child
	recognizes them.
_	Club hours are 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Please make the necessary arrangements to have your child/children picked up no later than 5:30 p.m. Any pick-up after 5:30 p.m. is considered a late pick-up.
	After 3 late pick-ups, your child/children will be dropped from the program.
_	Lunch and snacks may be provided for FREE for your children each day throughout the summer.
	Children may bring their own lunch & snack but we do not have bowls, plates or the ability to cook.
ч	<u>The Club is not responsible for lost or stolen items</u> . All belongings, especially swimsuits and towels, should be taken home every day. Lost and found is held for a period of one week and then donated to a

	Field Trips or "Stay at the Club Events" occur each week. All Club Members are expected to follow all rules

	We consider our programs to be a partnership between the families and Club staff. We will do what is
_	necessary to make this a successful summer for you and your child/children. We ask that all parents,
	guardians, and family members please show respect to our staff, volunteers, and other members. Any
	aggressive or disrespectful behavior will not be tolerated and will be subject to removal from the

_	injury to themselves or others, who are at risk to leave the premises without permission, whose disability
	is so severe they cannot participate in a majority of Club activities, who require assistance to use the toilet
	or who require a personal aide while attending school and whose aide does not accompany them at all
