Please read the following information carefully. You must sign at the bottom indicating that you understand and agree to **ALL** of the following.

Basic Information, Rules, and State Requirements

Please initial Enrollment: Enrollment is limited. Our hope is to have enough room for all students wishing to participate in our ASES Program; however, we cannot always accommodate everyone. After receiving your completed forms, the Program Coordinator will call to let you know if your child will be participating in the program and the date that they may begin. Each registration is considered at the principal's discretion. Attendance and Early Release Policy: In accordance with the California Education Code Section 8483(a)(1)(2)(3), the following attendance and early release regulations for the After School Education and Safety Program (ASES) are expected: The intent of the Education Code that participating students will attend this program regularly for the full program time, until 6:00p.m. Priority enrollment is given to pupils who are homeless or foster youth, and second priority to those that attend daily. Some exclusions may apply; please reach out to the Program Coordinator to discuss. Students may attend the program only on the days they attend school. Students who have excessive unexcused absences may be asked to leave the program. Student Pick-Up: Students participating in the ASES/ELOP Program must be signed out by a parent/guardian or someone designated on the registration form (designated persons must be 12 years of age and be listed on the registration forms). Your child must be picked up promptly at the end of the program. If your child has not been picked up by the end of the program, site staff will contact you and/or those individuals designated as emergency contacts. Three late pick-ups will result in your child being dropped from the program. In case of not being able to contact an adult, CPS (child protective services) or the police may be called. 4. Discipline: Participation in the ASES/ELOP Program is a privilege. A child must adhere to the Boys & Girls Clubs of Greater San Diego's Payne Family Branch club rules and Integrity Charter School's core day school rules. Disruptive or disrespectful behavior towards other students or staff is cause for dismissal. We encourage you to discuss concerns about your child's behavior with the Branch Manager. First Offense: Receive a written warning. Second Offense: Be suspended for 1 day. Third Offense: Be suspended for 2 days. Fourth Offense: Will be automatically dropped from the program. Parental Support: While the ASES/ELOP Program Staff are committed and qualified, your help is needed to make the program the very best it can be. You are an important partner in our program's success, and we look forward to your help with events and activities, tutoring, field trips, and other projects. Welcome to the Boys & Girls Clubs of Greater San Diego's Transportation Program. We are pleased that you have chosen the Club to provide safe and fun after-school activities for your child. In order to provide the safest program possible, the following rules will be enforced. Please review them with your child.

	All riders must always wear a seatbelt. NO EXCEPTIONS.
2.	Everyone must remain in his/her seat during the entire trip; no switching seats once the van/bus has started to move. All personal items including electronics must be in your child's backpack during the entire trip.
3.	IMPORTANT: Please call us at 619-477-5445 by 11:30 am if your child will not be riding the bus and will not be back at the school at the scheduled pick-up time. You are responsible for transportation to the Boys
	& Girls Club if your child is not present at the scheduled pick-up time.
	Children are to wait in the designated area assigned by the school. The bus leaves 10 min after the bell rings.
5.	We will NOT return to school to pick up a child that has missed the bus. If for any reason your child misses
_	the bus, please instruct your child to go directly to the school office and call you to arrange an alternate pick up. We are unable to go back for children who have missed the bus due to late dismissal or delayed arrival at the bus stop.
_ 6.	Non-registered children will not be allowed on the bus. Transportation paperwork must be on file at the Club
	office for your child to ride the bus/van.
	Your child should not attend if he/she is sick or not feeling well.
8.	Once a child is in possession of the bus driver, he/she cannot be released to anyone until they've
0	been driven and checked into the Boys & Girls Clubs. Please note: California Administrative Code, Title V, Section 14103 states:
_	"Pupils transported in a school bus or in a school pupil activity bus shall be under the authority of, and responsible directly to, the driver of the bus, and the driver shall be held responsible for the orderly conduct of the pupils while they are on the bus or being escorted across a street, highway, or road. Continued disorderly conduct or persistent refusal to submit to the authority of the driver shall be sufficient reason for a pupil to be denied transportation."
